How to Get Involved

Recognize and acknowledge an act of respect by a player, coach, parent, referee or administrator. If you observe someone taking the extra step to promote a more respectful atmosphere around youth soccer, we encourage you to nominate them as an NJYS Respect Ambassador by filling out the form at the link below.

NJ Youth Soccer will review nominations and recognize one (1) nominee each month as the NJYS Respect Campaign winner. The recipient will receive an award courtesy of various NJYS partners (e.g. New York Red Bulls, Gotham FC and Philadelphia Union). The recipient will also be recognized via NJYS digital communications (e.g. website, social media and monthly newsletters).

The girls were selected because of their dedication to helping others and making a difference in their community through soccer. After hearing about a request by Red Cross for the donation of soccer equipment for refugees residing at Joint Base McGuire, Dix Lakehurst, the team decided to take action. Pulling money from birthdays and allowances, the girls were able to purchase two dozen balls that were donated to the refugees. "Our girls hope the soccer balls give 24 young refugees in an uncertain situation a reason to smile," said Megan Khichi, a parent on the team. "It's a tangible way for these third and fourth graders to make a difference and help cheer up kids in need."





The balls were donated to Dogtopia in Tinton Falls, one of the drop-off locations for the Joint Base/Afghan refugees organized by the NJ Veterans Chamber of Commerce through Red Cross.

U11 Surge Red are the first to be named Respect Ambassadors through the NJYS Respect Campaign, which launched in April. The Respect Campaign, which was recently <u>featured by NBC New York</u>, is designed to improve the local soccer community and the experiences of all involved, both on and off the field.



Game & Weather Information

Game Tie Breaks



DETERMINATION OF TEAM WINNERS Each team will be awarded (3) points for a win and one (1) point for a tie.

In the event of a tie for a group (pool) winner, the following criteria will be used to break the tie:

- 1. Most Wins.
- 2. Head to head competition.
- 3. Fewest goals against.
- 4. Goal differential to a maximum of (4) per game.
- 5. FIFA penalty kicks to be taken at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the scheduled game.

In recognition of fair play, teams will lose one (1) point for goals beyond a six (6)-goal differential. For example, a 9-0 game will be scored as two (2) points for the winning team (three (3) for the win, minus one (-1) for goal differential penalty) and zero (0) for the losing team.

FINAL GAMES - If a game ends in a tie, kicks from the Penalty Mark will follow to determine the winner.

Weather Rules



- 1) We play thru rain, stop for thunder or lightning.
- 2) If for thunder or lightning, Tournament Director will sound 3 Bursts with Horn, there will be a 30 minute delay after the last clap or flash. Find Shelter!
- 3) If game is in the first half, start with the second half with reduced time.
- 4) If game is in the second half, Game is Final
- 5) We may reduce the length of games to allow all games to be played.

CANCELLATION/Disaster Preparedness Plan

In the event of inclement weather or for reasons beyond their control, the Tournament Director will have the authority to:

- 1. Relocate or reschedule any game.
- 2. Change the duration of any game.
- 3. Cancel any game. In the event of inclement weather forcing play to be halted and preventing the match from completing during the scheduled time, the score shall stand if at least one-half of the match has been completed. The tournament director will have the final decision on field closure.
- Every effort will be made to play all scheduled games. The Tournament Committee may cancel the tournament or any part of the tournament for reasons beyond their control. In the event of a cancellation prior to the start of the tournament, all teams shall receive a refund of 60% of the team entry fee. If the tournament is postponed or rescheduled prior to its start, a new permission to host application will be submitted to NJYSA and all teams that applied to the original date will be given the opportunity to withdraw from the revised date of the tournament with a full refund of their entry fees.
- 5. In case of inclement weather (Lightning) the Tournament Director will ensure the safety of all players and coaches by SOUNDING an air horn for 3 quick bursts. This will signal that the games are suspended until the weather has passed. All games will not resume until the last LIGHTNING strike and it has been cleared without a strike for 30 minutes. During the inclement weather ALL participants are encouraged to seek immediate shelter.

REFUND POLICY

Upon acceptance, the fee is non-refundable. If your team is accepted and later withdraws, the entry fee is non-refundable. Refunds will only be made if the tournament is cancelled as described in Rule 15.
