Parking Rules:

- You cannot park in ANY Fire Lanes (ticketed and towed)
- Park only in spaces that are marked for parking all locations – Monmouth Regional HS, OTHS and Joe Palaia Park
- 3. In the Joe Palaia exit loop, you are not allowed to park on the sides of the road as you exit (ticketed and towed)
- 4. Plenty of parking at EVERY location, park legally!
- 5. OTUSA will not be responsible if your vehicle is ticketed and/or towed due to illegal parking

Youth sports are as much about learning life lessons as they are learning the sport on the field. All of us at NJ Youth Soccer want to encourage everyone to work together to ensure our players are learning and implementing inclusion, acceptance, unity and respect in our soccer community.

This is not a temporary campaign but an ongoing commitment to improve behavior in New Jersey Youth Soccer. We thank you in advance for helping us create a more positive, inclusive and respectful environment for the game we all love.

How to Get Involved

Recognize and acknowledge an act of respect by a player, coach, parent, referee or administrator. If you observe someone taking the extra step to promote a more respectful atmosphere around youth soccer, we encourage you to nominate them as an NJYS Respect Ambassador by filling out the form at the link below.

NJ Youth Soccer will review nominations and recognize one (1) nominee each month as the NJYS Respect Campaign winner. The recipientwill receive an award courtesy of various NJYS partners (e.g. New York Red Bulls, Gotham FC and Philadelphia Union). The recipient will also be recognized via NJYS digital communications (e.g. website, social media and monthly newsletters).

GAME TIE BREAKS

DETERMINATION OF TEAM WINNERS Each team will be awarded (3) points for a win and one (1) point for a tie. In the event of a tie for a group (pool) winner, the following criteria will be used to break the tie:

- 1. Most Wins.
- 2. Head to head competition.
- 3. Fewest goals against.
- 4. Goal differential to a maximum of (4) per game.
- FIFA penalty kicks -to be taken at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the scheduled game.

In recognition of fair play, teams will lose one (1) point for goals beyond a six (6)-goal differential. For example, a 9-0 game will be scored as two (2) points for the winning team (three (3) for the win, minus one (-1) for goal differential penalty) and zero (0) for the losing team.

FINAL GAMES

If a game ends in a tie, kicks from the Penalty Mark will follow to determine the winner.



Game & Weather Information 2

WEATHER RULES

- 1. We play thru rain, stop for thunder or lightning.
- 2. If for thunder or lightning, Tournament Director will sound 3 Bursts with Horn, there will be a 30 minute delay after the last clap or flash. Find Shelter!
- 3. If game is in the first half, start with the second half with reduced time.
- 4. If game is in the second half, Game is Final
- 5. We may reduce the length of games to allow all games to be played.

REFUND POLICY

Upon acceptance, the fee is non-refundable. If your team is accepted and later withdraws, the entry fee is non-refundable. Refunds will only be made if the tournament is cancelled as described in Rule 15.

Game & Weather Information 3

CANCELLATION

In the event of inclement weather or for reasons beyond their control, the Tournament Director will have the authority to:

- 1. Relocate or reschedule any game.
- 2. Change the duration of any game.
- 3. Cancel any game. In the event of inclement weather forcing play to be halted and preventing the match from completing during the scheduled time, the score shall stand if at least one-half of the match has been completed. The tournament director will have the final decision on field closure.
- 4. Every effort will be made to play all scheduled games. The Tournament Committee may cancel the tournament or any part of the tournament for reasons beyond their control. In the event of a cancellation

- prior to the start of the tournament, all teams shall receive a refund of 60% of the team entry fee. If the tournament is postponed or rescheduled prior to its start, a new permission to host application will be submitted to NJYSA and all teams that applied to the original date will be given the opportunity to withdraw from the revised date of the tournament with a full refund of their entry fees.
- 5. In case of inclement weather (Lightning) the Tournament Director will ensure the safety of all players and coaches by SOUNDING an air horn for 3 quick bursts. This will signal that the games are suspended until the weather has passed. All games will not resume until the last LIGHTNING strike and it has been cleared without a strike for 30 minutes. During the inclement weather ALL participants are encouraged to seek immediate shelter.


